

NOTICE

The St. James Public Health Services has embarked on another phase of the Covid 19 Vaccination Intervention which involves the high schools. During this phase, students ages 12 to 17 years will be vaccinated with the Pfizer Vaccine. Parents/guardians, teachers, ancillary staff and in some cases, the community are invited to get themselves vaccinated on the assigned day. We will be coming to your school on **Friday, December 3, 2021 between the hours of 10:00 am and 3:00 pm.**

The available vaccines are:

- **Pfizer** - 1st and 2nd doses will be administered to persons ages 12 - 17 years and 50 years and over
- **AstraZeneca** - 1st and 2nd doses will be administered to persons ages 18 years and over
- **Johnson and Johnson** - one dose will be administered to persons ages 18 years and over

Please find attached, a registration form that should be completed by each person to be vaccinated (whether first of second doses) ahead of time. Each student (ages 12 - 17) must have a birth certificate, school ID or passport and each adult (ages 18 years and older) must have a valid government ID (passport or voter's ID) along with their TRN. In the absence of an ID a letter from a JP along with a passport size picture will be accepted. Students must take a letter of consent from their parents if they will not be present on the day. Consent form should reflect the names of the student and parents and an ID number for the parents.
